PUSHKAR - THE PEIRCE AND LESLIE WAY
November 15-19, 2010

For the fourth year Peirce and Leslie will have a private camp at the Pushkar Camel Fair. A small and intimate oasis of luxury, with just 25 tents, you will have the opportunity to see the authentic fair and absorb the local colors before other tourists have arrived. The fair dates are November 15-19, 2010.

The Pushkar Camel Fair is one of the most colorful events in the Rajasthani festival calendar. From all over Rajasthan the Rebari tribe, who are traditionally camel herders, walk for weeks across the desert to Pushkar where they gather in great numbers to trade their animals. Pushkar, though primarily a camel fair, also has horses and cattle for sale. Here you will see the colors of Rajasthan sartorially vibrant people, dance, music, and for a photographer, it is a bonanza of candid pictures.

Each air conditioned tent has wooden floors, and bathrooms with individual hot water geysers, showers and flush toilets. Heaters and hot water bottles are available at night, and a library tent is stocked with a small but interesting collection of books and magazines. All meals are served in an air conditioned dining tent, and each evening there is a performance of Rajasthani dance.

The camel fair is legendary, and the opportunity to watch a timeless ritual which has stayed largely unchanged over the years is exceptional.
